Midwest Poultry Research Program (MPRP)

COE Center of Excellence Scholarship/Internship Program

What is COE? No poultry science departments remain in MPC participating states. Thus, MPC members, along with university faculty and administrators, created a "Virtual Poultry Science Department" and the COE, largely funded by the poultry industry.

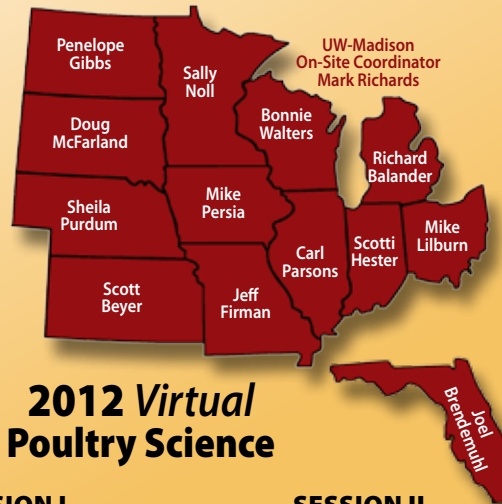
The Goal... Enhance poultry science education in member states and ensure availability of qualified graduates for employment within the industry.

Scholarships... Up to 30 students a year are awarded scholarships, including housing and up to 18 credits (two six-week summer sessions). Courses complement most majors and credits are transferable to the student's home university.

COE is unique... Students are guided through recruitment, education, internship, employment, and networking opportunities. The foremost faculty and industry experts provide a strong, research-based poultry science education, combining state-of-the-art labs, interactive classroom lectures, and field trips.

Wednesday Night Forums... Students interact with industry leaders and learn about career opportunities.

Internships... Companies provide on-the-job opportunities to students through paid internships.

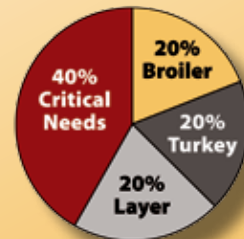
MPRP Midwest Poultry Research Program

What is MPRP? Established in 2002, MPRP is a public/private program created to effectively address research needs of the poultry industry in a competitive process. This program has helped engage the industry and renew interest among poultry students.

The Goal... Improve efficiency and sustainability of poultry production through integrated, collaborative research and technology transfer. MPRP focuses on priority areas of local need and problems of regional/national scope while encouraging multi-disciplinary research networks which enhance limited state and industry resources.

Industry Cash Match & University Collaboration... In years 2002-2008, preference was given to projects with at least a 25% cash match (vs. in-kind match) and those which collaborated with one or more universities. We are working with Congress to reinstate this language.

Funding... MPRP is responsible for nearly \$6 million in poultry research!
