The Midwest Poultry Consortium is organized to provide leadership, support, and resources for poultry education and research in member states.

COE Center of Excellence Scholarship/Internship Program

What is COE? There are no longer poultry science departments in MPC member states. Therefore, MPC industry members, along with university faculty and administrators, created a "Virtual Poultry Science Department" so students can earn poultry science credits.

The Goal... Enhance poultry science education in member states and ensure availability of qualified graduates for employment within the industry.

Scholarships... Over the last 5 years, the range was 26 – 36 scholarships awarded, including housing. These three-credit courses complement many majors and credits are transferable to the students' home universities.

COE is unique... Students are guided through recruitment, education, internships, networking opportunities, and employment. The foremost faculty and industry experts provide a strong, research-based poultry science education, combining labs, interactive classroom lectures, and field trips.

Wednesday Night Forums... Students interact with industry leaders and learn about career opportunities.

Internships... Companies provide on-the-job training opportunities to students through paid internships.
